tender box after 12:00. Tenders will be opened on the same day in the Committee Room at 12:05. Late or unmarked tenders will not be considered. No tenders per fax or e-mail will be accepted.

The programme is dependent on the availability of funding for the project and the tender will remain valid for three years until the programme is completed.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB and it is estimated that tenderers that wish to come in

contention should have a grading designation of 5EP or higher. The Contractor's grading must, however, be in accordance with the total sum awarded to that particular Contractor.

A compulsory briefing session will be held on Friday, 15 March 2024 at 11:00 in the Committee Room, George Municipal Offices, Electro Technical Services, Brick Road, George Industrial. All

briefing meeting that have reserved a document and who produce a receipt of payment.

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000) Regulations 2022 and the George Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy,

where 80 points will be scored for price and 10 points for B-BBEE status and 10 points for Locality.

Only Tenderers that meet the following pre-qualification Eligibility conditions will be considered:

Bidders are obligated to submit a tender offer that complies in all aspects to the conditions as
detailed in this tender document. Only those tenders that comply in all aspects with the tender

conditions, specifications, pricing instructions and contract conditions will be declared to be responsive.
Only those tender submissions from which it can be established that a clear, irrevocable, and unambiguous offer has been made to George Municipality, by whom the offer has been made

and what the offer constitutes, will be declared responsive.
The Bidder must provide information on a similar (minimum of R5m Contract value and electrification of at least 300 houses, including the Medium Voltage supply), project that has been completed in the past seven (7) years and a contactable Referee in relation to the similar project,

A Tenderer must be registered as an Electrical Contractor with the Department of Labour which
